



Lead Community Basketball Coach

Job Description

Community Coach in Crawley & surrounding areas, working during term time, with primary school children delivering breakfast, curriculum and after school clubs, starting September 2021.

The applicant will deliver Crawley Basketball League (CBL) sessions & games & National League sessions and games, in the evenings, on weekends & public holidays as required.

The candidate will be in charge of running fun and developmental sessions in schools to entice players to join the club sessions. The candidate will need to be a confident communicator and will also be in charge of the planning and oversight of the CBL and delivery of high quality National League sessions and game coaching.

Key Responsibilities:

Admin

- Attend any relevant courses and classes. Understand and follow Safety and Safeguarding
- Plan progressive sessions and send a full weeks plan the week before to the Head Coach.
- Compiling register of session attendance and commuting session details to parents
- To work with the head coach to develop activities to increase participation
- Email schools to set up Leagues & tournaments. Keep google calendar up to date with sessions
- Arrange fixtures with opposition teams
