Key Responsibilities:

- Team coaching and Fixtures (to be assigned by the Head Coach)

- Any admin required by the Leader of Learning or Head Coach in support of the Basketball programme (for example timetabling peris, registering players, arranging fixtures, completing EVOLVE paperwork)
